A comprehensive review has been undertaken for every unit across Monash Health aligned to new EMR workflows and patient safety requirements.

These devices are location-specific, so cannot be moved from one unit to another. There is tap on tap off (TOTO) functionality. When you tap off a device and tap on to another device it will open up the same screen you were on last.

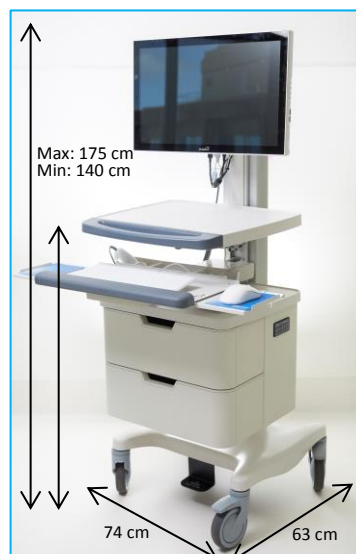
Only one patient chart can be opened on one device. However, you can use a device to access any patient's chart, and multiple people can access the same patient's chart at once across different devices.
