## Medication IV set – order sentences

The EMR upgrade has removed the “Infuse Over” time unit default of **hours** in all IV set & infusion orders.

Please ensure that you complete any IV set or infusion orders using either:

- o Rate (“Infuse Over” will be automatically calculated), or
- o Manually include the time unit if using “Infuse Over” eg. 8 hr(s)
