Viewing A Summary Of The Patient's Active Alerts

Within the EMR Patient Record, a new **“Alerts Summary”** tab has been created in the Table of Contents menu (blue section located to the left side of the screen when a patient chart is opened).


The Alerts Summary tab can be found above the **“Diagnosis, Alerts and Problems”** tab and conveniently groups only the problems that have been identified as Active Patient Care Alerts.


